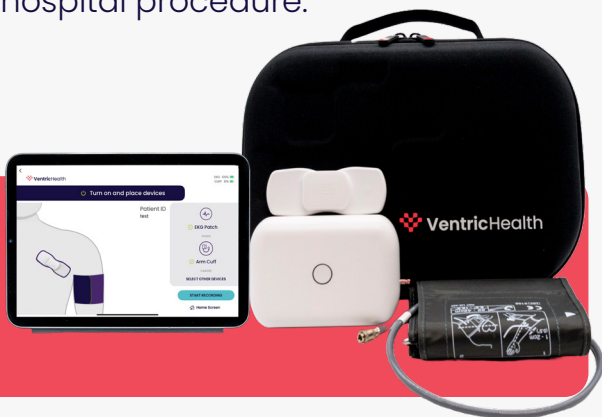

What is the Vivio® Test?

The Vivio test is a quick, non-invasive way to check how well your heart is functioning. It measures pressure inside your heart—something that traditionally required a hospital procedure.

What does it measure and why does that matter?

Your heart fills with blood before each beat. If pressure builds up, it can be a sign your heart is working harder than it should.

The Vivio test helps your doctor detect:

- Early signs of heart failure.
- Changes in heart function over time.
- Issues that may not show up on other tests.

Why is my doctor recommending this test?

Your doctor may recommend Vivio if you:

- Have risk factors such as diabetes, kidney disease, high blood pressure or obesity.
- Have symptom like shortness of breath, fatigue or leg swelling.
- Needs a clearer picture of your heart beyond what standard tests provide.

Vivio gives your doctor additional insight to help guide your care before symptoms become serious.



Catching changes in heart function early can help you get the right treatment sooner.

What should I expect during the test?

The Vivio test is simple, quick and easy:



1. A cuff is placed on your upper left arm (similar to a blood pressure cuff).



2. A small monitoring patch is placed on your upper left chest.



3. You sit still and breathe normally for a few minutes.



4. The device records your heart's signals.

That's it. Done in less than five minutes. No recovery time. You can return to normal activities right away.
